



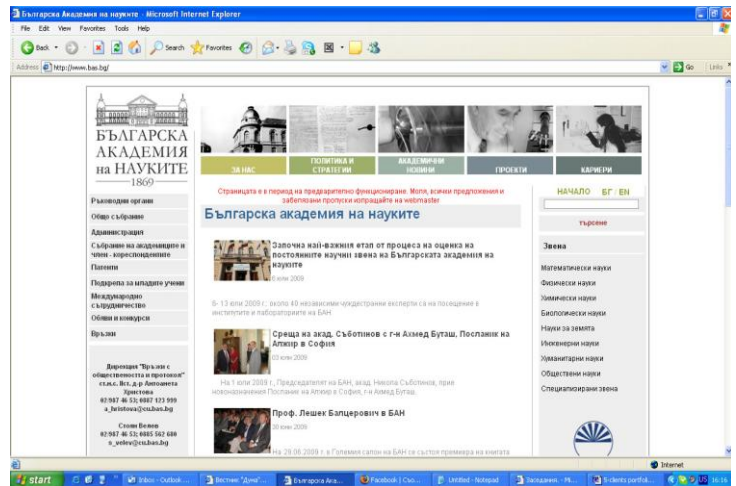
Bulgarian Red Cross www.redcross.bg

The Bulgarian Red Cross uses Content Management System (CMS) FACE CONTROL for its website. The information is available in two languages – Bulgarian and English. The members of the Bulgarian Red Cross manage and update the information on the website by themselves. They publish and change the information and the image of the website without the assistance of IT specialists. It took them just one week of training that ELIDO provided.

The Bulgarian Academy of Sciences uses the FACE CONTROL content management system for their website. It has complex structure that contains information about all institutes of the Academy. The information is separated by units and branches. The main page provides up to date and detailed information, differentiated in sections; normative documents; news and events; publications; bulletins; advertisements and competitions; exhibitions; gallery. The information is available in two languages – Bulgarian and English.

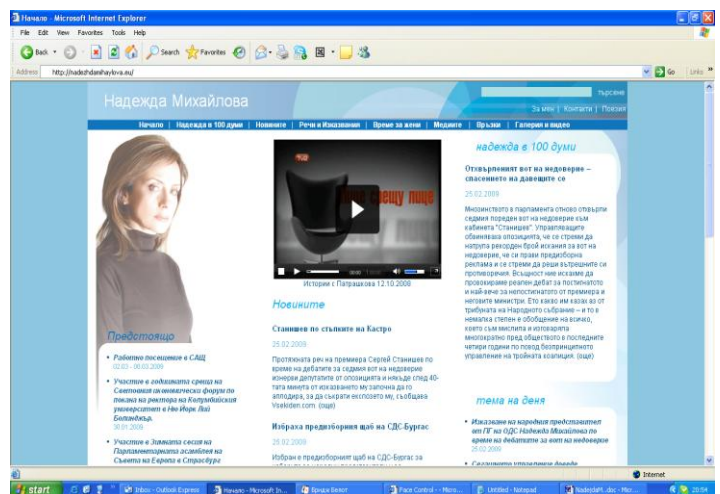

The personal website of the vice-chairperson of the National Assembly on the side of the United Democratic Forces, Mrs Nadezhda Mihaylova, was created with the Content Management System (CMS) FACE CONTROL.

The webpage is a useful source of information, combining the public appearance and the private life of the female politician. Some of the information sections are: news, statements and speeches, publications, calendar of events, etc. The content of the website is enriched with a photo gallery and video materials, representing the political life and media appearance of Nadezhda Mihaylova – as a woman of the year (the "Grazia" magazine), as a presenter of the "Piramida" TV show, as a model in "The Blue Angel" photo session (the "EVA" magazine).

The navigation is facilitated by the built-in search tool. Some useful links to similar specialized websites are also available. Two additional modules have been integrated – a mail list and a feedback form.



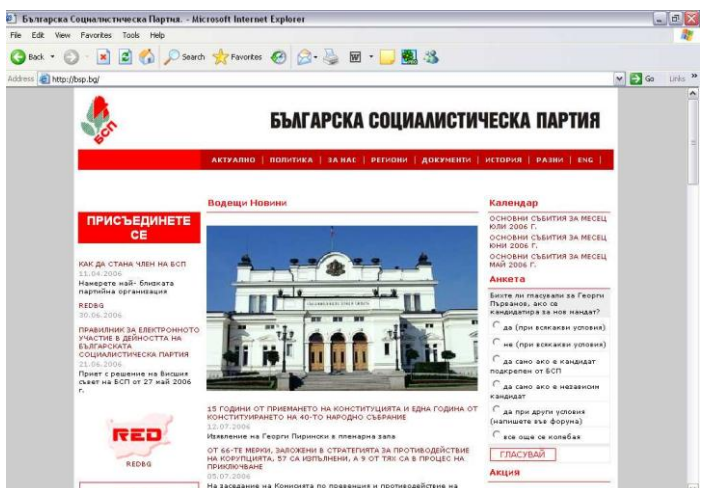
InvestBulgaria agency (IBA) www.investbg.government.bg

InvestBulgaria Agency (IBA) chose the content management system – FACE CONTROL – CMS for its Internet project. The IBA website offers useful information about: the reasons to invest in Bulgaria, the country profile, gives some facts and figures, legal framework, lists the attractive industries, success stories, informs about events, news and publications. For the Internet project of the well-known Bulgarian agency- InvestBulgaria Elido Media team created the website architecture and structuring. The web content (= web information) updates are fully powered by the advanced content management system – FACE CONTROL. The built-in search engine assures easy and user-friendly website navigation. The website is available in 5 languages- English, Bulgarian, Italian, Spanish and Japanese (short version)



Bulgarian Socialist Party (BSP) www.bsp.bg

The official website of the Bulgarian Socialist Party was created with the content management system FACE CONTROL. It's a very complex website divided in 28 regions. Each region is a fully functional website with its own sections – forum, news, events etc. The regions are edited and maintained by BSP members with no more than standard computer literacy and a couple of days training with FACE CONTROL. The website is bilingual – Bulgarian and English. The main website www.bsp.bg offers abundant information about the activities of the party. An additional feature allows regional editors to define certain information as one of national importance and it appears also on the main page. There are polls and a built-in search engine for easy navigation.

The website has a video section, polls section and a built-in Search Engine for easy navigation. The website is in three different languages – Bulgarian, English and Turkish.

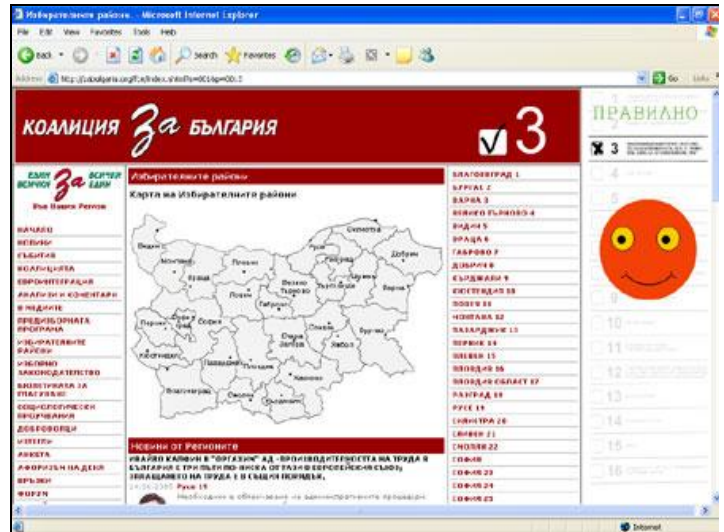
The official governmental website was launched on the 29 of September 2005. It was officially presented to the media on the press-conference, opened by the Prime- Minister Sergey Stanishev and given by an authorized representative of GIS.

The Internet media resource provides information, related to the work of the Bulgarian government, press-conferences, decisions, meetings, projects, parliamentary control, projects, speeches, decrees, pm biography, photo gallery, media etc. The visitors' opinion can be expressed in the feedback form, available on-line. The website is currently available in Bulgarian and English. The site map and the key-word search enable an easy navigation within the information.

The website of the Coalition for Bulgaria represents very complex Internet project with more than 31 local websites, integrated in the main one-www.zabulgaria.org. All these web projects are created and are supported with FACE CONTROL- CMS. Editors/non-technical people from different regions of the country publish/unpublish and edit information. The website contains more than 1000 single information. It was launched after only 2 weeks- design, architecture creation and basic information input in the website. In the same time a train-the-trainer strategy was applied, which enabled so many editors in different geographic locations to work with the system simultaneously.



Forest Development Project
